Head north from Cairns to Cooya Beach where you will learn traditional aboriginal practices and knowledge on a Kuku Yalanji cultural habitat tour. Walk through the World Heritage listed Daintree Rainforest, the earth's oldest at 180 million years old. Cruise the Daintree River observing crocodiles, pythons and birdlife among the mangroves. Observe the nocturnal behaviour of tropical creatures at night in Cape Tribulation's rainforest. Traverse the iconic 4WD Bloomfield Track to Cooktown enjoying stunning scenery and visits to the iconic Cedar Bay National Park and the Lion's Den Hotel along the way. Learn of this frontier land's history and the main players in the many layers of Australia's past including Captain James Cook. From Cooktown fly at a low altitude along the Great Barrier Reef and up Cape York Peninsula, viewing all there beauty on the World's Longest Scenic Flight. Land on one of the idyllic islands of the Torres Strait for a tour with locals of World War 2 sites and see Australia's northernmost point. Explore rarely seen Aboriginal rock art galleries with Willie Gordon, a renowned traditional owner interpreting songlines and learn about traditional bush tucker and medicine. The Atherton

Tablelands host ancient crater lakes, gigantic trees, wondrous waterfalls and an abundance of birdlife and unique wildlife including platypus and tree kangaroos. Follow the Wheelbarrow Way and visit the historic mining towns of Herberton and Irvinebank and the art deco drenched Innisfail. View the rainforest canopy from the Mamu Skywalk and meet cassowaries at Etty Bay. Ramble around the enchanting Paronella Park and picturesque Dunk and Beddara islands and snorkel and scuba dive the outer Great barrier Reef. Walk in the rainforests of laid back Mission Beach. Ride the Savannahlander train and at Chillagoe explore all things subterranean in Australia's prettiest limestone caves and wonder at the dark skys from the observatory at night. Enjoy unsurpassed views of the Wet Tropics World Heritage Area from the Skyrail Rainforest Cableway and Kuranda Scenic Railway plus a guided tour of the best exhibition of tropical plants in Australia at the Cairns Botanical Gardens. Chill out at the most luxurious hotel and top class restaurant in Cairns as you reflect on your action packed adventure of a lifetime!
